SYDNEY: Male / Female / Junior / Cadet
30 arrows @ 70m/60m/50m/40m (122cm face)
➤ Veterans Division for 50-59 & 60+ will be held in Open Recurve & Open Compound only.
➤ There will be a Barebow Open Division & Longbow Open Division only.

SHORT ADELAIDE: Intermediate / Cub
30 arrows @ 50/40 (122 face), 30*/20* (80 face)

DATE:

Sunday 21st February 2010

ENTRY FEE:

\$22.00 for Male/Female/Junior/Cadet
\$18.00 for Intermediate/Cub

GRADES:

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There will be Open Divisions in all grades. If an archer has never competed in some style of event please state this on the entry form as N/C.

LOCATION:

Northern Beaches Campus (*formerly known as Cromer High School*), South Creek Road (Inman Reserve), DEE WHY WEST.

COMMENCES:

Registration commences at 8.30a.m, Practise @ 9.00 with the first arrow being shot at 9.30 a.m.

AWARDS:

Medallions will be given for 1st, 2nd & 3rd placings in each division where applicable.

CLOTHING:

Whites or registered club uniform must be worn.

TEAMS EVENT:

There will be a Perpetual Trophy award for both Recurve & Compound Teams. Team of 4 archers shooting the Sydney Round.

Note: Archers must be registered to the Society through the one club

There will also be a Perpetual Trophy for winning ladies team of 4 competitors (maximum of two compounds), all shooting the Sydney Round.

MATCH PLAY KNOCKOUT:

At the conclusion of the Tournament, the top 10 archers regardless of sex will be invited to take part in a Match Play Knockout. Archers will be ranked from the Tournament, whereby an invitation will be extended to participate. Archers will then shoot three arrows from which the lowest score is eliminated. In the event of a tie, those archers concerned will be allowed a one arrow shoot-off whereby the closest to the centre will advance to the next round, until there is only one competitor left. Spectators are most welcome.

ALLOCATIONS:

Archers are requested to register on arrival.

CLOSING DATE: **6th February 2010**

Space will be limited, therefore entries will be taken on a first received basis, **entry fee must accompany registration form.**
