### QRE events: Open to all members.

Members should be encouraged to shoot in their respective division, however, the club will allow members to shoot a lower division)

### Divisions are:

**Male Open / Junior Boys:** Long Fita = (36 arrows @ 90/70/50\*/30\*

**Lady Open / Junior Girls / Male Masters /**

**Cadet Boys:** Short Fita = (36 arrows @ 70/60/50\*/30m\*

**Cadet Girls / Male Veterans / Lady Masters & Veterans / Male & Lady Longbow / Male &**

**Lady Barebow:** Fremantle = (36 arrows @ 60/50/40m\*/30\*m

**Intermediate Boys/Girls:** Intermediate round = 36 arrows @ 55/45/35\*/25\*

**Cub Boys & Girls:** Horsham round = 36 arrows @ 40/35/30\*25\*

Members wishing to participate in these events need to let the club know prior to the date set. Just turning up on the day is not the norm. An email to Steve Salmon advising round / division that you will be competing in – is necessary. This is a controlled event and you should be made aware that:

- No latecomers will be accepted
- Expect to shoot entire event (5 hours)
- Equipment Checks – mandatory & enforced
- Double scoring applies

Refer to club calendar to see what date suits you and then register accordingly.
