Tournament Update

2007 ASNSW STATE INDOOR AND NATIONAL INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

EVENT: 18m FITA Indoor (60arrows) each day

DATE: 28th and 29th July 2007

VENUE: Minto Indoor Sports Centre, 9 Redfern Rd, Minto

ENTRY FEE: \$65.00 (including Judges Levy & \$5 AA entry)

DIVISIONS/ROUNDS: All divisions will be catered for, and all divisions shoot an 18m FITA Indoor with compound freestyle scoring inner 10.

COMMENCES: Flight allocation and starting times will be advised as soon as entry numbers are known.

The event will run over 2 days with possible flights each day, depending on the number of entries. Archers must nominate either a 3 spot or a single (40cm) target face.

Saturday: Recurve AM and Compound PM

Sunday: Compound AM and Recurve PM.

The standardised practice is to be: 20 min practice - 5 min break - scoring commences.

CLOSING DATE: 16/07/07

(No late entries will be accepted)

AWARDS: Medallions will be awarded at the conclusion of the event for State Indoor. NSW archers will only receive a state medal if participating at the NSW allocated venue. National championships medals will be awarded as follows: Less than 3 entrants: Gold, Only 3 Entrants Gold and Silver, More than 3 entrants Gold, Silver, Bronze.

CLOTHING: ASNSW Tournament Dress Code applies.

GENERAL: Venue has a canteen.

Moving Targets: (Running Animal, 12 arrows.

Rolling Disc, 12 arrows)

Speed Round: (30 seconds to shoot as many arrows into static targets)

Aussie York Round: (Distance of 100, 80, 60 & 40 yards, total of 24 arrows)

Spot Light Shoot: (6 Targets randomly Spot Lit)

Sunday: 9.00 am

Muster: Hawkesbury Field Round (Two challenging 10 target courses set in a bushland setting. 3 arrows per target. Unmarked traditional distances)

Entry Fee: Adults \$25.00 ~ Jnrs. \$15.00 ~ Cubs free ~ Family \$40.00 ~ (\$15.00 for one day)

Pay on the day. Please register with the Club President by 21st August 2007.

Awards: Trophies awarded to the highest scoring Selfbow, Longbow and recurve archer.

All division places will receive a certificate.

Facilities Availability: Camping in designated areas, toilets, shower available, canteen facilities. Motel accommodation is available. (for details contact the club president)

Club Rules: All visitors and competitors must register on arrival at the grounds

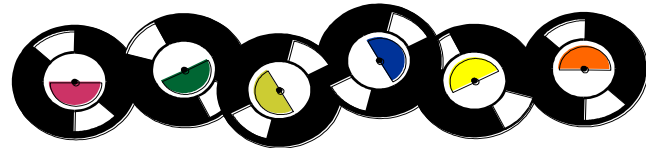
