Trans-Tasman 2008: Congratulations to Jack Salmon for winning the **GOLD** medal at the 2008 Trans-Tasman competition held in New Zealand. Jack shot in the Intermediate Boy Compound division and scored 1308 & 1353 (2 GMB scores) with a total Score of 2661 – Awesome effort.

AIS Invitational Shoot: In July/August 2007 the Australian Institute of Sport (AIS) Archery program extended an invitation to select members of the world's recurve archery nations to participate in its 2008 AIS Archery International. National teams from some of the world's top ranked countries, including Korea, Great Britain, the U.S.A., Malaysia, France and Chinese-Taipei, accepted the invitation and arrived in Canberra during mid January in preparation for the event.

The International was loosely divided into two phases, a training and assessment opportunity in the first 5-6 days (18-23 January) followed by a competition period (23-26 January). The competition was a 72 arrow ranking round conducted on the AIS Outdoor Synthetic Pitch followed by Elimination and Finals Matchplay on Canberra Stadium. Korea once again proved the team to beat filling all individual female and two individual male places as well as having two teams of each gender win medals. Irrespective, AIS archer Ha Neul (Sky) Kim maintained the fantastic form that saw him with the 2007 Olympic Test Event and was able to defeat Lee Seung Yong (KOR) to win gold in the individual men's discipline for Australia. Former AIS Scholar and Beijing Olympic aspirant Matt Gray also featured in the medal matches but lost to Im Dong Hyun in the bronze medal match.

Aimee participated in the event in the individual event ranked 32nd in the ranking shoot – scoring 276 points, finishing in 23rd place making it to the 1/16 round. Aimee teamed up with Jade Lindsay & Dawn Lowther to contest the teams event and made it to the 2nd round, only just being pipped by Korea.

Australian Open Nationals: by Ian Stokes

Warringah Archers were represented by two archers at the 2008 Open Nationals held in Morewell, Victoria from the Sunday 23rd to Friday 28th of March. They were:

Aimee Deaves - Open Womens Recurve (*member of the NSW State Team*).

Ian Stokes - Masters Mens Longbow

The events for the open womens recurve and masters longbow were two days of target, one day of clout, two days of field.

Monday and Tuesday: FITA Target rounds. Weather was good, clear skies and little wind. Scores were generally high with Pat Coughlan SA (Mens Open Compound) shooting 1401/1394 for the F90 round.

Wednesday: Clout. Weather was total rubbish - cold, variable tail winds and rain. Most archers shot a better afternoon round as the weather cleared a little. No surprises that scores were generally low.

Thursday and Friday: 24T FITA Field rounds. Morning weather was foggy, cold (5-6 degrees) with light wind on both days. Everyone started slowly in the cold. Scores were generally good in the conditions. The only real downside to the shooting was the difficulty everyone experienced getting their arrows out of the tough target butts.
