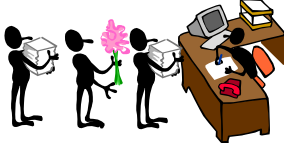

Well done to all our Junior members who competed in this years Warringah Kidbow Tournament and a special mention should go

to **Jaime Van Barbieri** who scored a Perfect Round **900 out of 900, shooting 85 'x'**, that makes it two junior archers who have scored the magic 900 in New South Wales, and they both come from Warringah Archers. The 1<sup>st</sup> Junior to achieve this was Adrian Harper shooting in the Cadet Boy Compound Division, Jaime would be our first junior achieving it in the Intermediate division – well done.

Welcome also to David & Daniel Hodge, who have just joined our shooting line as members.

Going forwards we will be introducing a new section within the newsletter which will make archers think about some of the shooting rules you need to be aware of especially when competing in tournaments away from the club.

Thanks to our resident Judge Steve Salmon for providing the following question for this edition (*Wonder how many will come up with the right answer, which we will print in December edition*).

### How well do you know Tournament & Shooting Rules - YOU BE THE JUDGE what would you do?

**At an outdoor target tournament, during the first scoring end, an archers scope/tripod falls over, due to the legs not being properly locked in.**

**The archer waits for the competitors around him to complete shooting before re-setting the scope and calls an equipment failure as there is not enough time left to complete his arrows for that end.**

**You are the Judge called to handle this situation. What do you do?**

### Equipment Inspections.

Equipment Inspections before a tournament are an opportunity for you to check that your equipment is legal before scoring begins. Make sure you bring all the equipment you use on the shooting line with you to the inspection. This includes your fully set-up bow, arrows (including spares), release/tab (including spares), but does not include spotting scopes. Your arrows should be clearly marked with either your name or your initials and these markings must be on the shaft (not the fletching). In addition the fletching, nocks and wraps should be consistent in colour and size. See FITA rule 7.3.1.7.1.

*"An arrow consists of a shaft with head (point) nock, fletching and, if desired, cresting.*

*The maximum diameter of arrow shafts will not exceed 9.3mm, the heads (points) for these arrows may have a maximum diameter of 9.4mm.*

*All arrows of every athlete must be marked with the athlete's name or initials on the shaft, and all arrows used at any end will carry the same pattern and colour(s) of fletching, nocks and cresting, if any."*

Please check your equipment and see if you are prepared to compete in a tournament???

The morning of the shoot, I asked many more questions (*some the same as the previous night*), so I thought I'd practice a little more as well until it was time to go.

When I got to the club, I'm sure there were butterflies rushing through my stomach, and heaps of bits & bobs of things going through my head, like did I have everything that I needed? or how would I manage with the sight settings since I had only shot at 20 meters once before?, so with a big deep breath I walked through the club gates.

During the event Michael Salmon helped me understand many of the rules, such as why we mark each arrow hole, the meaning of the one meter line & the reason we counted x's and 10's, thanks Michael.

I was really excited when they called my name out to get a bronze medal, and next year I will be better prepared – **Bring it on!!!!**

### All Gold Awards:

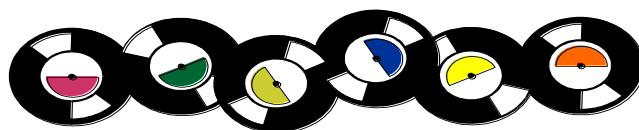

If you do not wish to purchase any of these awards, please do not tick the box. They will not be sent to you unless you chose this method.
