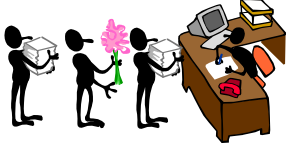

CLOUT CLASSIFICATIONS

Obtaining your clout classification is calculated a little bit differently to what is required for Target/Indoor & Field. In Target/Indoor/Field you have to attain a certain rating to obtain your classification, however, in Clout your score determines your classification regardless of the distance you are shooting.

Grand Master Bowmen:	306
Master Bowmen:	285
1 st Class	260
2 nd Class	200
3 rd Class	170

The above score must be shot to obtain the appropriate classification and of course you must still obtain three of them.

The medals are silver in colour with a yellow triangular (depicting the clout) in the centre.
